AP 5140 STUDENT ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES (SAS)

(Formerly Disabled Students Programs and Services)

References:

Title 5 Section 56000 et seq.

The District maintains a plan for the provision of programs and services to students with disabilities designed to ensure that they have equality of access to District classes and programs.

At a minimum, the procedures, plan, or description of the program and services will address:

- procedure for timely response to accommodation requests involving academic adjustments which, at a minimum, provides for an individualized review of each such request, and permits interim decisions on such requests pending final resolution by the appropriate administrator or designee;
- long-range goals and short term measurable objectives for the program;
- definitions of disabilities and students eligible for the program;
- support services and instruction that is provided;
- technology accessibility;
- verification of disability;
- student rights and responsibilities;
- academic accommodation plan that is developed by a designated person in consultation with the student;
- academic adjustments, auxiliary aids and services, and/or instruction;
- provisions for course substitution and waivers;
- staffing; and
- advisory committee
- a procedure for faculty consultation when an accommodation might result in fundamental alteration to course curriculum.
