BP 5050 STUDENT EQUITY AND ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM**References:**

The District shall provide Student Equity and Achievement Program services to students to further equality of educational opportunity and academic success. The Board expects the Student Equity and Achievement (SEA) Programs to specifically identify and close opportunity gaps that impact student success and improve the District's commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion to better support student success. The purpose of SEA Program services is to enhance student access to the District, to promote and sustain the efforts of students to be successful in their educational endeavors, and to bring the student and the District into agreement regarding the student's educational goal through the District's established programs, policies, and requirements.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures to ensure implementation of Student Equity and Achievement Program services that comply with the Title 5 regulations.
