## BP 5410 ASSOCIATED STUDENTS ORGANIZATION ELECTIONS

## References:

Education Code Section 76061;
College of Marin Associated Students' Election Code
The Associated Students Organization shall conduct annual elections to elect officers. The elections shall be conducted in accordance with procedures established by the District.

Any student may run for office to be a part of the Associated Students Organization as long as they adhere to the requirements outlined in this Board Policy. A student elected as an officer in the Associated Students Organization shall meet any of the following requirements:
(a) (1) The student shall be enrolled in the District at the time of election and throughout the student's term of office, with a minimum of five semester units.
(2) The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship (see BP 4220 Standards of Scholarship and related administrative procedures), and the student shall hold and maintain a 2.5 GPA at the time of their appointment and throughout their term in office.
(b) The student shall be enrolled in an adult education program offered by the District at the time of the election and throughout the student's term.
(c) The student is enrolled in the District at the time of election, and throughout the student's term, and is a student with a disability.
